What is it?/How is it used? Luminaries are small lanterns. They can be made of any material with fire safety in mind and can be used on The Altar to manifest intentions by infusing 'Sun' energy with the

activation of Fire

Ingredients:

- 1. 1 large Navel Orange
- 2. 2 colored tea-light candles (yellow/red)
- 3. Sand, soil or crushed shells

Construction:

- 1. Cut the orange into 2 equal halves & scoop/eat pulp
- 2. Dehydrate orange halves with lowest oven settings or dehydrator and fill with sand/soil
- 3. Add a small tea light in the sand/soil & secure with sand on all sides
- 4. Discard any moldy orange halves and refresh/recreate as needed
